MICROFILM COPIES OF UNPUBLISHED GERMAN PATENT APPLICATIONS

Availability for inspection in the Patent Office Library

Notice is hereby given that, on and after the 1st November, 1948, there will be available for public inspection in the Patent Office Library microfilm reproductions of approximately 146,000 unpublished applications for patents filed by enemy nationals in the Reich Patent Office (Germany) which were found to be intact at the end of the war and impounded by the Allied Control Authorities. The microfilm, of which a small proportion is hardly legible due to faulty processing, is divided up into 100 ft. length reels and each reel relates to a particular class of subject-matter and, in some cases, to more than one class.

The following are the class numbers and subject-matter headings and the figures in parentheses indicate the number of applications falling within each class:—
